

Loarning Focus:

Reading: Our reading focus to begin Term 3 is all about maintaining fluency. To be a fluent reader there a few things that we need to focus on when reading aloud:

- Accuracy Reading the words correctly.
- Rate Not reading too fast or too slow.
- Phrasing Grouping words together to make meaning.
 - Expression Reading with emotion in our voice.
- Punctuation Pausing appropriately at punctuation.

Writing: We are currently learning about Procedure Texts in writing. Procedure texts tell us 'how to' to do something and include a title, goal, materials/equipment/ingredients and sequential steps.

Maths: In maths students are learning all about Fractions as well as 2-dimensional shapes and 3-dimensional objects!



- Centrelink Customer Reference Numbers (CRNs) for yourself and your child if you would like to claim Child Care Subsidy (CCS). Note that the person completing the enrolment must be the same person linked to the child for CCS
